

STUDENT TIMELINE: YEAR 1

JOIN NEEMA

Students start their life at Neema in early January. Students and their guardians are invited to the Father Heart of God seminar the month prior.

ANNUAL MEDICAL CHECKUP

All students receive an annual check-up to identify any underlying medical issues. Students and children receive ongoing medical care during the year.

DRESSMAKING & TAILORING I CLASS

Students start their skills training program with an emphasis on both theory and practice.

RECEIVE BIBLE

Each student receives her own Bible that she will use throughout her stay at Neema and keep after she graduates.

INTRODUCED TO REINTEGRATION PROGRAM

Students start to study Livelihood & Social Skills that will help them with their life after Neema.

INDIVIDUAL & GROUP COUNSELING

Our counselors meet with the students on a regular and on-demand basis to help them cope and heal from past trauma.

ALPHA SEMINAR

Trained pastors come and teach the Alpha Seminar, a key pillar of Neema's discipleship program.

RECEIVE UNIFORMS

Third Year students make the First Year students' uniforms, which they are eager to receive.

STUDY THE YOUNG PEACEMAKER

Students are introduced to understanding, responding to, and preventing conflicts. They also learn how to resolve a conflict in a constructive and biblically faithful manner.

PARTICIPATE IN CATERING CLASSES

Our Chef teaches the benefits of nutrition and some easy recipes for the students to make at Neema or when they go home.

TAKE ENTRY-LEVEL NITA EXAM

In December, students take their first certification exam.

STUDY WOMEN OF THE BIBLE SERIES

They read, tell, and engage with Women of the Bible stories—often hidden or untold—not only because they are inspirational, but also because these stories invite our students to experience God in ways that are sure to transform their lives.
